



Annual Home Game Admission Passes are Back!



We are excited to announce that Annual Passes to home athletics events are once again available for purchase! Passes are valid for the entire 2021-22 academic year, at either high school or middle school home games.

The three types of passes available are:

Annual Pass – Family \$100

This pass may be used by the entire family, a portion of the family, or any individual within the immediate family for admission.

Annual Pass – Student \$40

This pass may be used by one individual K-12 student for admission.

Annual Pass – GrandPartner \$25

This pass may be used by one individual aged 55 or older for admission.

With the admission charge set by the Black Forest League for HS Events at \$6 for adults and \$5 for students, these passes will pay for themselves quickly!
