Parents Need to Sign In Tardy Students

TARDY POLICY

A friendly reminder to parents that in order to excuse a student when he or she is tardy to school, a parent is required to come to the Main Entrance (the South Entrance) and sign the student in (see page 13 of the US Parent-Student Handbook). A tardy may be excused for good reason such as sickness in the family, car trouble, or inclement weather. Nonetheless, parents

must sign in their children before the tardy child can be admitted to school.

A Front Desk staff member will give students a pass before going into class. Students who are late while Morning Assembly is still taking place must be signed in to excuse the tardy. For students who drive themselves, they will be considered unexcused if they are tardy unless the tardy is due to inclement weather. A parent/guardian may also notify the school if the student driver was late for another serious reason such as car trouble.

Over the next week, we will offer courtesy calls and emails as families adjust. But starting on November 15th, this will be the expectation.

Vision and Hearing Screening - November 9-11

Students will have their vision and hearing screenings November 9-

11. Screenings are done according to Colorado State Guidelines. All students in Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th grades are screened. Only NEW students in 4th, 6th, 8th 10th-12th grade are screened, as well as any student on an IEP or 504 plan. The screening includes a basic vision acuity and pure tone air conduction hearing screening. If your student wears glasses or contacts, or if they use a hearing aid, please ensure they have them during the testing week. Please be aware that you will only be notified if your student fails the vision and/or hearing screening.


