Front Desk Reminders

Please note the important reminders of new procedures due to the pandemic. We apologize for the inconvenience.

- No visitors in the building, including parents/guardians.
- Picking up your child early?
 - Email <u>macattendance@maclarenschool.org_</u>24 hours in advance.
 - Ring the bell at South Door.
 - Show ID at the camera This is MANDATORY for pickup.
- Child is arriving late for school?
 - Email maclarenschool.org with reason for tardiness so that it can be excused. If you do not send an email, the tardy will be unexcused.
 - We are no longer asking parents to sign their child in; instead they must email MacAttendance so that the tardy can be excused.
 - Please do not come in the building when bringing your child to school just drop

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off at the South Door and ring the bell.

Label! Label! Label!

This weekend, please **label all of your child's belongings** with their name - fleece, sweaters, hoodies, water bottles, pencil bags, etc. We cannot assist in getting lost possessions back to their rightful owner if they are not labeled with a name.



Drop-off & Pick-up Reminders

- 1. We do not have permission to park in the church lot across the street.
- If you have any Upper School student in your carpool, even if you also have Lower School students, pick-up time is at 3:35 (Mon-Thurs) or 2:45 p.m. (Fri). Unfortunately, we do not have the parking capacity for you to pick up Lower School students and then park and wait.
- Students should not be getting into or out of cars unless the car is in the pick-up/drop-off lane or is parked in a parking space. Please do not let kids out of your car on Murray.
- Drivers should use their turn signals when in the parking lot, in the pick-up/drop-off lane, and on Sawyer.
- It is a Right-turn ONLY out of the MacLaren parking lot
- 6. At all times, drivers should observe standard rightof-way laws. Right-turning traffic off Murray should NOT stop and allow left-turning vehicles to go ahead. Similarly, vehicles turning right into the parking lot should not pause to allow left-turning traffic off Sawyer.
