#### **Front Desk Reminders**

- · Picking up your child early?
  - Email <u>macattendance@maclarenschool.org</u> 24 hours in advance.
  - Ring the bell at **South** Entrance. (see image)
  - Show ID at the window or to the camera This is MANDATORY for pickup.



- Email <a href="mailto:macattendance@maclarenschool.org">maclarenschool.org</a> with reason for tardiness so that it can be excused. If you do not send an email, the tardy will be unexcused.
- We are no longer asking parents to sign their child in; instead they must email MacAttendance so that the tardy can be excused.
- Please do not come in the building when bringing your child to school just drop off at the South Door and ring the bell.

# **Drop-off & Pick-up Reminders**



- We do not have permission to park in the church lot across the street.
- If you have **any** Upper School student in your carpool, even if you also have Lower School students, pick-up time is at **3:35** (**Mon-Thurs**) or **2:45** p.m. (**Fri**). Unfortunately, we do not have the parking capacity for you to pick up Lower School students and then park and wait.
- Students should not be getting into or out of cars unless the car is in the pick-up/drop-off lane or is parked in a parking space. Please do not let kids out of your car on Murray.
- Drivers should use their turn signals when in the parking lot, in the pick-up/drop-off lane, and on Sawyer.
- It is a Right-turn ONLY out of the MacLaren parking lot.
- At all times, drivers should observe standard right-of-way laws. Right-turning traffic off Murray should NOT stop and allow left-turning vehicles to go ahead. Similarly, vehicles turning right into the parking lot should not pause to allow left-turning traffic off Sawyer.
- Please do not drive through the apartment complex across the street. Those living there have noticed people speeding through which has put some of the residents there at risk.
