 school. Be prepared to show identification to be cleared to enter the school where
 you will be able to retrieve the materials from the locker yourself.
- If your child has been quarantined or isolated due to COVID, your child's Dean or teacher will gather all of the necessary academic materials and leave them at the

Main Entrance. The Front Desk team will reach out to you when the items are ready to be picked up.
