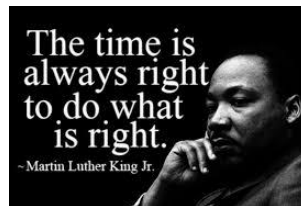

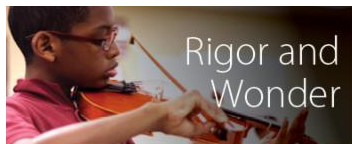

The Counselor Corps Grant is a renewable \$80,000 grant that allows us to add staff and programming to our counseling office.
