	Take your medical exams if possible. You will be notified by the DODMERB as to the particulars—do not procrastinate!!! Results will be forwarded to all of the academies & ROTC if you so designate.
	Try to visit the academy that is your first choice.
	Start filling out the applications from the academies— plan on submitting your completed application, along with teacher recommendation forms & your transcript ASAP after school starts.
