Academic Common Market*

Allows students to study in a specialized field at an out-of-state college, while paying in-state tuition rates. Participating states include: Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana, Tennessee, Kentucky, West Virginia, Delaware, Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Georgia
